



Mentored Youth Trout Days

March 28 (regional) April 11 (statewide)

8:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. each day

Youth anglers and their adult mentors can get an early start fishing and “Catch the Value” on the two Mentored Youth Trout Days on ALL Commission stocked waters managed under Commonwealth inland regulations. March 28 is the regional day for the 18 southeastern Pennsylvania counties and April 11 applies statewide. Visit www.fishandboat.com/stocked.htm to see which waters are stocked by the Commission.

To participate:

- Adult anglers (16 years of age or older) must possess a valid Pennsylvania fishing license and a current trout/salmon permit and be accompanied by a youth angler (less than 16 years of age) who has a Mentored Youth Fishing Permit or Voluntary Youth Fishing License.
- Youth anglers must possess a free Mentored Youth Fishing Permit or a Voluntary Youth Fishing License (\$2.70 cost).

- A youth angler must be accompanied by an adult angler when participating.



When fishing:

- The minimum size for trout is 7 inches long.
- The creel limit will be 2 trout (combined species) per angler.
- All other Commonwealth inland regulations apply.
- Stocked waters are considered Approved Trout Waters.
- These days DO NOT INCLUDE special regulation waters.
