DOCKS REMOVED AT FRANKFORD ARSENAL & COMMODORE BARRY ACCESS ON DELAWARE RIVER

Philadelphia, PA – The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) will conduct the annual removal of the floating docks and walkways at the Frankford Arsenal Access on November 3rd, and from the Commodore Barry Access on November 4th. The docks will be replaced in the spring of 2010. Exact dates will be determined based on weather and site conditions next spring.

The PFBC manages some 300 state properties to provide free boat launch and/or fishing opportunities on the waters of the Commonwealth. The Frankford Arsenal Access is one of the most popular public recreational fishing and boating sites on the lower Delaware River.
