### **Addition to List of Class A Wild Trout Waters 2007**

The Fish and Boat Commission (Commission) has approved an addition to the list of Class A Wild Trout Streams as set forth in 37 Pa. B. 1194 (March 10, 2007). Specifically, the Commission added Tannery Hollow Run, Section 01, in Cameron County. Tannery Hollow Run is a tributary to Sterling Run. Section 01 extends for a distance of 2.75 miles, from the headwaters downstream to the mouth.

Pursuant to 58 Pa. Code §57.8a (relating to Class A wild trout streams), it is the Commission's policy to manage self-sustaining Class A wild trout populations as a renewable natural resource and to conserve that resource and the angling that it provides. Class A wild trout populations represent the best of this Commonwealth's naturally reproducing trout fisheries. The Commission manages these stream sections for wild trout with no stocking.
