Classification of Wild Trout Streams
Additions, Deletions and Adjustments to List
2008

The Fish and Boat Commission (Commission) has approved additions, deletions and adjustments to its list of wild trout streams as published at 38 Pa. B. 1330 (March 15, 2008) with the exception of the removal of Mahoning Creek, Montour County. The Commission did not approve the removal of this stream from its list of wild trout streams.

Under 58 Pa. Code §57.11 (relating to listing of wild trout streams), it is the policy of the Commission to accurately identify and classify stream sections supporting naturally reproducing populations of trout as wild trout streams. The listing of a stream section as a wild trout stream is a biological designation that does not determine how it is managed. The Commission relies upon many factors in determining the appropriate management of streams.
