



2010 PFBC Lake Habitat Management

We would like to thank all of our habitat partners and project cooperators for making 2010 a successful year for the Lake Habitat Section. This year we were able to visit over 40 different water bodies across the state. In doing this we accomplished 50 projects (Volunteer Scale & Large Scale combined), completed 21 layouts and we monitored results at 6 reservoirs. The 50 projects resulted in **1,488** new fish habitat improvement devices. The 21 layouts ensures that we have much more work to do at some new lakes in our program as well as some that can use our continued support. In cooperation with DCNR, US Army Corps of Engineers, Penn State University, Ohio DNR and PFBC's Division of Fish Management we have been able to monitor results at six reservoirs across the Commonwealth.
