2023 Largemouth Bass Survey



Fisheries Biologist Aide Elliot Hoogerland with a 20 inch Largemouth Bass collected from Hills Creek Lake in June 2023.




Figure 1. Length frequency distribution of Largemouth Bass collected on June 7, 2023 in Hills Creek Lake.

<u>Hills Creek Lake</u> is a 137-acre impoundment located in <u>Hills Creek State Park</u> in Tioga County. Fisheries Management Area 4 biologists conducted a night boat electrofishing survey of Hills Creek Lake on June 7, 2023, to collect Largemouth Bass. Total night electrofishing catch rate for Largemouth Bass was 43.9 fish/hour. The bass ranged from 3 to 20 inches in total length (Figure 1.) The catch rate for bass \geq 12 inches was 23.7/hour, and the catch rate for bass \geq 15 inches was 7.9/hour (Table 1). A previous bass electrofishing survey conducted on the lake in 2015 produced slightly higher catch rates though sampling conditions in 2023 were less than optimal due to thick near shore vegetation. The data indicate that anglers currently have the opportunity to catch some nice bass with trophy potential given the good catch rates of fish \geq 15 inches and the capture of a 20 inch individual.
