

Tentative Stocking Report Instructions

Please complete and return a copy of the Tentative Stocking Report to the Cooperative Nursery Unit (CNU) by **March 5th** of each year. This allows the PFBC (CNU, Division of Fisheries Management, and Bureau of Law Enforcement) to review the scheduled stockings and specific locations to recommend any changes if necessary. The Tentative Stocking Report can be found digitally on our website to allow for ease with typing out stocking information.

Date or Week of

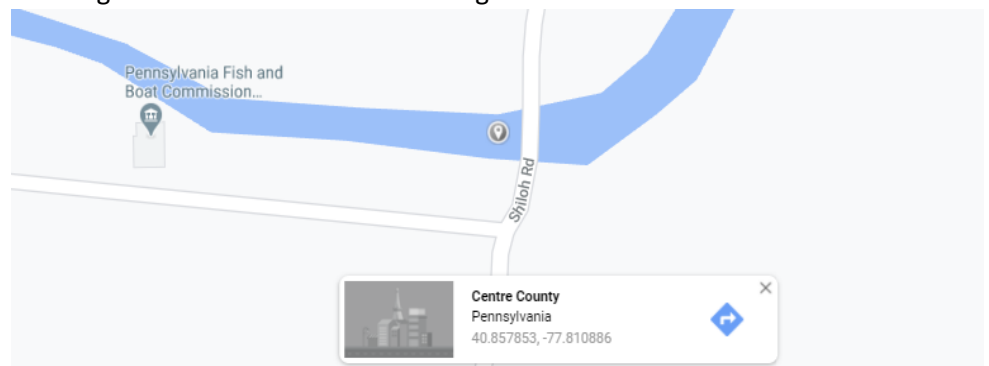
- List the date or the week of (if exact date is not known) that your club plans to stock. These dates are tentative and can be subject to change. Providing the CNU with these dates will ensure there will be no conflicts with PFBC stockings.

Stream or Water

- List the appropriate name for the body of water that your club will be stocking.
 - If your club stocks both a lake and the stream associated with that lake, please separate those entries on the tentative stocking as those are considered two separate bodies of water.
 - If your club stocks multiple sections of the same stream, i.e. Fishing Creek – Sections 1,2, and 4, it is allowable to have those as one entry with each section listed if they will be completed on the same day. If those sections will be stocked on separate days, please list each individual section as its own line.

Stocking Point (Begin) and Stocking Point (End) Section

- List a descriptive location that can be used to easily identify the area being stocked. When listing, please use the upstream most point in the “Stocking Point (Begin)” section and the lowest most point in the “Stocking Point (End)” section.
 - When listing the descriptive location, use a description that the CNU can easily figure out since we are not familiar with most of these streams.
 - Acceptable descriptions include GPS Coordinates and cross street information.
 - GPS Coordinates can be easily be determined by using Google Maps. When Google Maps is open, click on the map and a box will appear, showing the coordinates in Decimal Degrees for the location selected.



- When listing street information, you can list:
 - Bridge on Shiloh Road (only if there is one bridge)
 - 200 Yards Upstream of Shiloh Road Bridge
 - Intersection of Shiloh Road and SR 26.
- Do **NOT** use descriptors the CNU cannot determine without physically being there or knowing the area.
 - Random Name Hunting Camp, Spring Tree Farm, Red Barn, Railroad Bridge, Random Person's House.

Stream Section

- List the appropriate stream section for the body of water you are stocking.
 - Stream sections can be determined by using the online Stream Section Map. The map can be found by accessing the Fish and Boat Commission's website (www.fishandboat.com) and by using the search function and searching "Stream Section Map" If you need assistance with using this, follow the instruction sheet on the Cooperative Nursery Unit portion of the website or by contacting the CNU.
 - If you do not know the stream section, contact the CNU or your local WCO.
 - The CNU is currently working on identifying all stream sections stocked by cooperative nurseries and will be supplying you with a list of correct stream names and sections for waters reported. This list can be used to fill out future stocking information on Tentative Stocking Reports and Annual Reports.

Trout Species

- List the estimated number of each individual species that you plan to stock.
