
Care of the Catch

Keeping your catch

If it is legal and you are prepared, you may choose to keep your catch. To do this properly you need to dress the catch. Ask an adult to dress your catch. When keeping a bass, use a blow to the fish's head to stun it, making it easier to handle. Cut the "belly" of the fish from the anal vent to the throat, removing the

entrails and gills. Rinse the fish with clean water and keep it cold, or it will spoil. Bass and other sunfish family members are best prepared by filleting. Sunfish should be kept alive as long as possible, and may be filleted without first dressing them.
