

BE EQUIPPED

Smart boaters make sure they have the right safety equipment to keep them safe. This equipment is required by law.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: YOU MUST HAVE THESE ITEMS ON YOUR BOAT.

Match the letter describing each item of required safety equipment to the picture on the boat.

A. Wearable life jacket for each person on the boat.
Designed to keep you afloat if you fall overboard.

B. Throwable cushion or ring buoy.
Throw this to someone who falls overboard.

C. Bow lights. A red and green light on the bow (front). Lets other boats see you and shows them which way you are going.

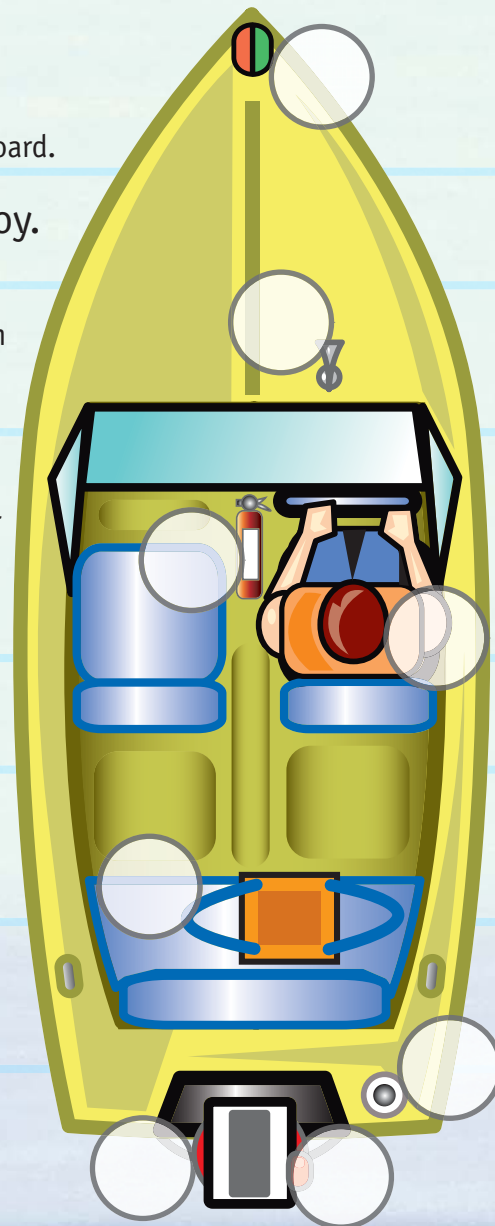
D. Stern or anchor light.
A white light on the stern (back). Lets other boats see you and shows them which way you are going. Hint: This light is the only one used when you anchor your boat.

E. Horn. Sound the horn to let other boaters know where you are.

F. Fire extinguisher. Pull the pin and squeeze the trigger to put out a boat fire.
Hint: Must be placed near the boat operator.

G. Ventilation hoses.
Remove gas fumes from inside the boat that could cause a fire or explosion.

H. Backfire flame arrester.
Prevents any engine sparks from causing a fire or explosion.
