- Trees showing the undersides of their leaves

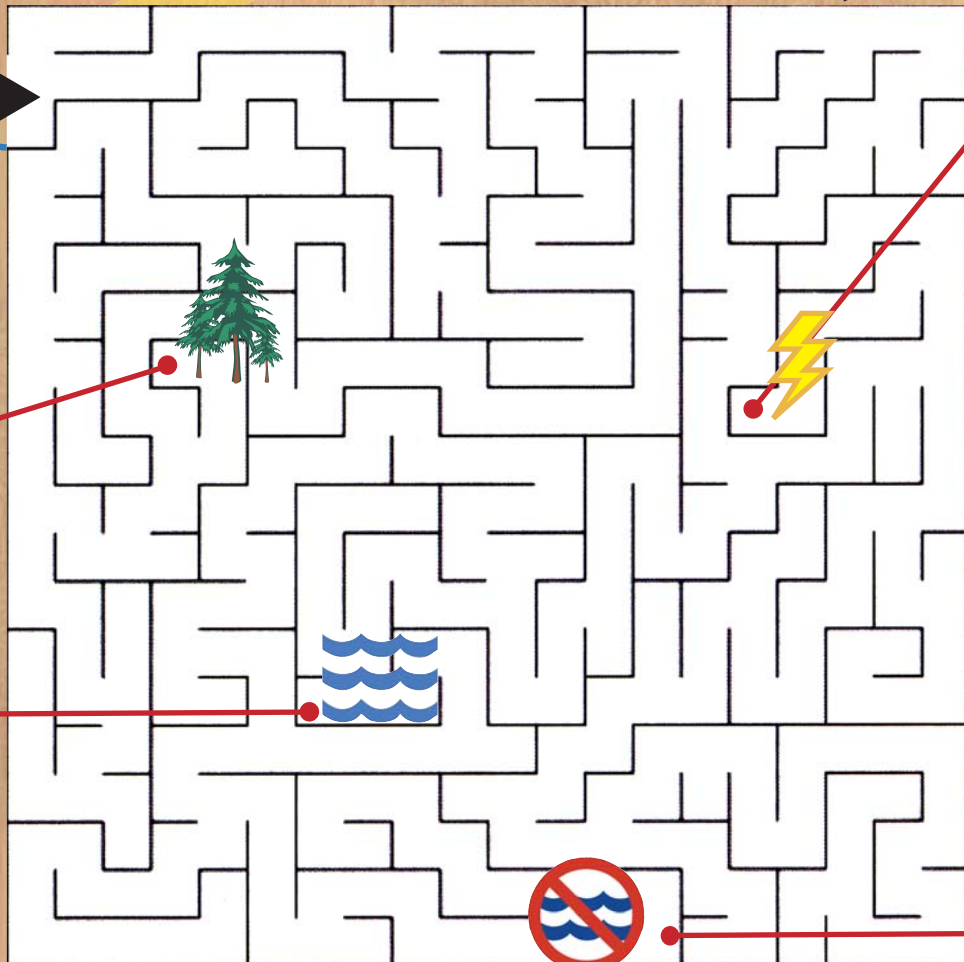
If you see any of these signs of bad weather, move indoors right away. Lightning can strike miles ahead of an approaching storm. Better safe than stranded—or worse!
