What do all living things need to survive? That's right! You need a home (shelter), food, water, oxygen and space. This is a habitat.

The recipe for a great trout habitat is cold, clean, fresh water with a mixture of large and medium rocks, pebbles, undercut banks, root systems and vegetation. Trout, crayfish and mayflies love gravel stream bottoms with bubbly riffles.

A warm-water pond, with plenty of vegetation, tree trunks and ample food can be a great habitat for bass.
