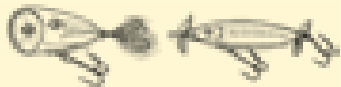


Getting Started-Fishing Fun!

Luring Lunkers with Lures

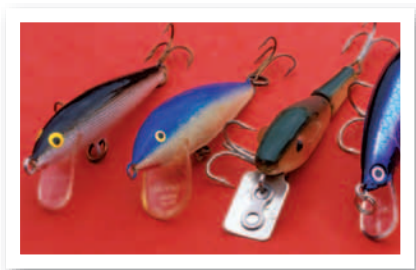
Do you need some help choosing a lure or not sure how each one works?



- **Jigs** – These have weighted heads and hooks that are paired with soft plastic, hair or feathers to wiggle to attract fish.



- **Spinners** – These are lures with blades that spin to create flash and vibration.



- **Crankbaits** – These are baitfish imitations with plastic lips that cause them to dive and wiggle.



- **Surface lures** – These are lures that splash or pop on surface when reeled in.

A Fishy Recipe

Try making your own dough balls. They work great for carp and catfish. Follow this recipe and see what you can catch.

Ingredients:

- Flour
- Sugar
- Cornmeal
- Water

Mix the four ingredients. The amounts of each are up to you. Just make sure the end result is a doughy consistency.

You may even want to add some flavor. Try mixing extracts with the dough. Vanilla, licorice (anise), orange, lemon, maple, almond, peppermint or wintergreen may be in your kitchen cupboard. You can try your own combinations, and find what is most successful. Many anglers also add gelatin powder mix to their dough to create irresistible bait that works for both carp and catfish.
