Work Summary

--Stream Habitat staff worked on a total of **78** projects.

--A total of **70** construction projects were completed.

--Of the 70 construction projects, **28** were on **priority waters**.

--A total of **1346** structures were placed in Commonwealth streams with our assistance.


-- PFBC Habitat Managers are working closely with Area Fisheries Managers to select “Priority Waters” to focus the majority of their habitat improvement work. A total of **7.67** miles of stream was improved (with 5.18 miles on these priority waters – (68% of the total).

Financial Summary

Almost **one million dollars** of habitat work was completed through the PFBC in 2013 (see details below).

--The PFBC total cost for stream projects was **\$48,842.31** (This included materials purchased & staff composite rates). Funding generated from outside sources totaled **\$947,297.54**. A total of **\$996,139.85** was spent on habitat projects with PFBC assistance.

(NOTE: For every \$1 the PFBC put towards habitat projects, \$19.39 was contributed from other outside sources).



--The PFBC was reimbursed a total of **\$103,461.70** for staff time and expenses (Loyalhanna Watershed Project, NorthCentral Habitat Project, Spring Ck Habitat Project, Cambria Co Conservation District Habitat Projects).

--The anticipated amount of reimbursement for 2014 for the Stream Section is at least **\$64,000** (Loyalhanna Watershed Project, NorthCentral Habitat Project, Cambria Co Conservation District Habitat Projects, Perkiomen Watershed Project).
