



Application for Amphibian and Reptile Educator Possession Permit



This permit is specifically for amphibian or reptile educators described in the application and may not be transferred to non-specified persons. Assistants must submit their own application. Upon the expiration of the permit, the permit is null and void. The permittee is required to comply with all appropriate standards of care for the animal regarding housing, sanitation, temperature, food, water and veterinary care and annual reporting. Release of native animals must meet requirements of PA Code 79.11. Amphibians and reptiles housed permanently and used for education are permitted under a Permanent Possession Permit (PA Code 79.4).
