

Where are the Fish?

To find fish, you will need to learn how to be a fish detective.

Here are some clues to help you out.



Clue #1: Food

This one is simple—fish need food to survive. Your catch will be found where food is available. Crayfish, small minnows and aquatic insects are important members of aquatic food chains. Find the food, and you will find bigger fish.



Clue #2: Shelter

Shelter provides a hiding spot and shade from the sun for fish. Underwater logs, stumps, rocks, weeds, brush piles and boat docks provide shelter, shade and protection for fish.



Clue #3: Habitat

All fish need food and shelter, but many fish tend to hang out in certain areas of the water. For example, some fish may like rocky areas while others like vegetation. Some fish can be found in shallow waters while others hang out in deep waters.
