Silver Shadows

Labeled as "silver shadows," "chromers" or "silver bullets," Pennsylvania's steelhead are some of the most respected and hard-to-find fish you will ever chase. Known for their strength, acrobatics and survival, these fish provide an experience like no other. Steelhead fishing is an experience all anglers should place on their list of things to do.



During October through April, about 100,000 anglers journey far and wide to fish Lake Erie's tributary streams for steelhead. Anglers travel to these cold waters to get the feel of the season's "first strike." This hooks many for life and sends reels screaming, hearts racing and trout dancing across the water, luring anglers time and time again.
