

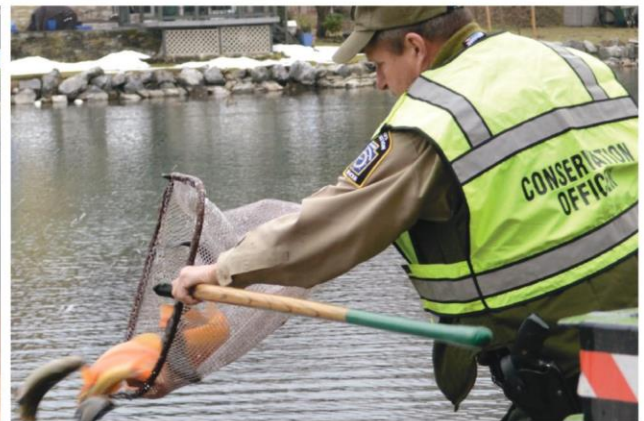

The Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission (PFBC) Bureau of Law Enforcement is seeking 20 qualified candidates for the position of Waterways Conservation Officer Trainee.

The State Civil Service Commission will begin accepting applications January 30, 2019 through February 19, 2019.

- Pennsylvania Residency is REQUIRED, must be 21 years of age to apply
- Pennsylvania Driver's License is REQUIRED
- Must pass Criminal History check
- Starting salary of TRAINEE is \$31,345 plus comprehensive benefits, to include Law Enforcement Retirement Program (Age 55, 25 years of service)
- Will attend 1 year of comprehensive, paid training at the academy (housing and meals provided), and complete ACT 120 and specialized Conservation Law Enforcement programs
- Promotion to WATERWAYS CONSERVATION OFFICER upon completion of training
